HARVEST AMENITIES

The HUB 1301 Homestead Way

This is the HOA office located directly across the street from the yellow farmhouse. Our office is open Monday-Saturday 9:00 am-5:00pm, Saturday by appointment only. We also have rooms available to rent at the HUB. All rental forms can be found at www.harvesthoa.com.

The Kitch 1301 Homestead Way

The outdoor kitchen has two gas grills and is located behind the gym. The Kitch is first come, first serve and for homeowners' usage only. The grills are available from 11am to 11pm. Homeowners are encouraged to clean-up after grilling so they are ready for the next homeowner. Instructions on how to use the grills can be found on www.harvesthoa.com.

The Gym 1301 Homestead Way

The Gym is located beside The HUB and is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week. In order to access The Gym you will need to have your FOBs. The bathrooms by the Gym are also FOB accessible 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Gym rules and videos on how to use the equipment can be found on www.harvesthoa.com.

The Hall 1251 Homestead Way

This all-purpose facility is where many of our community events are held. The Hall is also open for homeowners' usage, Monday- Friday 9:00 am-5:00pm and is located next to the pool.

The Splash 1251 Homestead Way

Two resort style pools surrounded by cabanas and seating, all overlooking the Harvest Lake are FOB accessible Monday-Sunday from 6am-9am (adult swim) and 9am-9pm (all swim).

Harvest Lake

The Harvest Lake is a man-made, 11-acre lake that anchors the entry into the community and offers fishing for residents. It is stocked with bass and catfish and is catch and release.

The Event Lawn

Located between The HUB and The Hall.

The Red Barn 801 Sunflower

The Red Barn is located on Sunflower by 8th street. The Red Barn cannot be reserved. It is available on a first come, first serve basis. This is a great place for neighbors to gather! There is plenty of seating, giant games, fire pits, and a half-court basketball goal.

Meadows Pool House 1770 9th St.

Resort style pool surrounded by cabanas and seating located on 9th and Meadows. Pool is FOB accessible Monday-Sunday from 6am-9am (adult swim) and 9am-9pm (all swim). The restrooms are FOB accessible all year around.

The Back Porch 709 8th St.

The Back Porch is located in Harvest Townside at the corner of 8th and Gazebo. This amenity features indoor space with wine and beverage coolers, patio seating, giant couch swings, bocce ball court, covered patio, outdoor kitchen with a Green Egg, pizza oven, and infrared grill. The Back Porch is FOB accessible from 9am-10pm and can not be reserved.

The Front Porch 1690 Treeline Dr.

The Front Porch is located along central park at the corner of Old Justin Road and Treeline. This amenity features an event pavilion, event stage, fire pit area, grills, event lawn, restrooms, trials and an exploration park. The Front Porch restrooms are FOB accessible 24 hours a day, seven days a week

The Fit Barn & Porch Pool 1740 Treeline Dr.

The Fit Barn and Porch Pool is located along central park at the corner of Old Justin Road and Treeline. This amenity features an indoor/outdoor fitness area, pool, volleyball court, half-court basketball goal and restrooms. The Fit barn and restrooms are FOB accessible 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The Porch Pool is also FOB accessible Monday-Sunday from 6am-9am (adult swim) and 9am-9pm (all swim).

The Bark Park 2119 Sunflower Ave

The Bark Park is located along central park at the corner of 18th street and Treeline. This amenity features a small dog area, a large dog area, an open green space and a watering station. The Bark Park is open from sunrise to sunset.
