

Harvest Homes Recycling & Waste Service Guide



Basic Services & Schedule

Waste Collection

EVERY WEDNESDAY (once a week)

Bundled Brush & Bulk Collection

EVERY WEDNESDAY. Up to 2 cubic yards (approximately 3'x3'x6') will be collected.

Recycling Collection

EVERY WEDNESDAY

On-Call Fee Service - to request a special brush and bulk collection, please call **817.953.7214**.

When should I set my carts out?

Be sure your recycling and waste carts are set out for collection by 7 a.m. on **WEDNESDAY**.

Cart Placement

Place your recycling and waste carts 2' away from each other and away from the edge of the street. Make sure the handle is facing your house, so that the lid opens toward the street. Please check to see that they are not obstructed by parked cars, boats, etc.

Bundled Brush & Bulk Collection

Brush and bulk items are collected **EVERY WEDNESDAY**. Brush must be cut to 4' lengths and tied in bundles. Furniture, boxes and other household items too big to fit inside your cart and construction debris (generated from your house only) will also be collected. Non-compactibles like brick, concrete, dirt, composition shingles, etc. must be placed in carts. Carts and bundles must not weigh more than 50 pounds.

Extra pickups may be scheduled for a minimum charge with payment in advance. Additional carts may be ordered for a minimum monthly charge. You can request a cart repair when needed. For new services, please contact Cheryl Heilman at **817.953.7214**.

Always place these items in your recycling cart:

Paper



Magazines, catalogs, mixed papers and mail



Shredded paper



Cardboard (flattened)



Newspapers



Phone books



Boxboard, cereal boxes, frozen food boxes

Plastic



Plastic tubs



Plastic jugs and bottles

Metal



Clean metal food cans



Aluminum cans and foil

Glass



Glass jars and bottles



Pots and pans, scrap metal, ceramics

Never place these items in your recycling cart:



Electronics



Batteries



Flower pots and plastic toys



Hazardous or toxic product containers



Frozen food bags



Chip bags



Polystyrene foam containers and packing peanuts



Plastic or metal hangers



Food-soiled paper



Light bulbs, drinking glasses or other glassware
