

## Recommended Plant List for Harvest, Phase 16 For the Architectural Corner Plantings – 2024

### Color Chart:

Very drought tolerant - **Red**

Moderately drought tolerant - **Green**

Slightly drought tolerant - **Blue**

Not drought tolerant - **Purple**

### Trees for corner (plant only 1 at least 12 feet away from foundation of home in center of open area):

1. Ginkgo biloba, **Ginkgo - Moderately drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**
  - Autumn Gold (fruitless male, yellow gold in fall)
  - Princeton Sentry (fruitless male, upright, conical shape, gold in fall)
2. Koelreuteria paniculata, **Goldenrain Tree - Moderately drought tolerant**
3. Pistacia chinensis, **Chinese Pistache - Moderately drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**
4. Quercus virginiana, **Live Oak**, select Highrise or Cathedral varieties- **Moderately drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**
5. Taxodium ascendens, **Pond Cypress - Moderately drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**
6. Ulmus alata, **Winged Elm - Moderately drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**
7. Ulmus crassifolia, **Cedar Elm - Moderately drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**
8. Zelkova serrata, **Japanese Zelkova – very drought tolerant - Moderately drought tolerant**

### Large Accent Plants for corner (plant 1 at least 12 feet away from foundation of home in center of open area; plant 2 if there is space to plant both 12 foot from foundation and 12 foot apart on staggered spacing):

1. Cotinus obovatus, **American Smoketree – Very drought tolerant**
2. Ilex var. Eagleston, **Eagleston Holly - Slightly drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**
3. Ilex var. Opaca, **American Holly - Slightly drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**
4. Lagerstroemia indica var. Basham's Party Pink, **Basham's Party Pink Crape Myrtle – lavender pink – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**
5. Lagerstroemia indica var. Miami, **Miami Crape Myrtle – Light lavender – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**
6. Lagerstroemia indica var. Muskogee, **Muskogee Crape Myrtle – Light lavender – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**
7. Lagerstroemia indica var. Natchez, **Natchez Crape Myrtle – White – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**
8. Lagerstroemia indica var. Sioux, **Sioux Crape Myrtle – vivid pink – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**
9. Lagerstroemia indica var. Tuscarora, **Tuscarora Crape Myrtle – coral pink – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**
10. Lagerstroemia indica var. Tuskegee, **Tuskegee Crape Myrtle – dark pink – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant**

**Small Accent Plants for corner (plant 2 at least 8 feet apart on staggered spacing):**

1. Ilex var. Mary Nell, **Mary Nell Holly** - Slightly drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
2. Ilex var. Nellie R. Steven's, **Nellie R. Steven's Holly** - Slightly drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
3. Ilex vomitoria var. Pride of Houston, **Pride of Houston Yaupon Holly** - Moderately drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
4. Ilex vomitoria var. Will Fleming, **Will Fleming Yaupon Holly** – upright, 1-2' spread, no berries - Moderately drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
5. Lagerstroemia indica var. Acoma, **Acoma Crape Myrtle** – white with weeping, cascading growth habit – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
6. Lagerstroemia indica var. Cheyenne, **Cheyenne Crape Myrtle** – bright red – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
7. Lagerstroemia indica var. Christiana, **Christiana Crape Myrtle** – dark red – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
8. Lagerstroemia indica var. Hopi, **Hopi Crape Myrtle** – medium pink – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
9. Lagerstroemia indica var. Pecos, **Pecos Crape Myrtle** – medium pink – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
10. Lagerstroemia indica var. Tonto, **Tonto Crape Myrtle** – deep red – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
11. Lagerstroemia indica var. Zuni, **Zuni Crape Myrtle** – lavender – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
12. Magnolia grandiflora var. Teddy Bear – **Teddy Bear Magnolia** - Moderately drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
13. Vitex agnus-castus, **Vitex** – Blue Diddley variety – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
14. Vitex agnus-castus, **Vitex** – Delta Blue variety – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
15. Vitex agnus-castus, **Vitex** – LeCompte variety – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
16. Vitex agnus-castus, **Vitex** – Montrose Purple variety – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
17. Vitex agnus-castus, **Vitex** – Pink Pinnacle variety – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
18. Vitex agnus-castus, **Vitex** – Salina's Pink variety – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
19. Vitex agnus-castus, **Vitex** – Shoal's Creek variety – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
20. Vitex agnus-castus var. Cooke's White, **Cooke's White Vitex** – white variety – Very drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant

**Plants for front of electric meter boxes planted in beds (plant 1 only):**

1. Ilex var. Liberty, **Liberty Holly** - Slightly drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
2. Ilex var. Mary Nell, **Mary Nell Holly** - Slightly drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
3. Ilex var. Nellie R. Steven's, **Nellie R. Steven's Holly** - Slightly drought tolerant, Cotton root rot tolerant
