



## THE BARK PARK

### **Hours of Operation: Sunrise to Sunset**

**The Bark Park may be closed for maintenance without prior notice.**

People who violate these rules are subject to removal from The Bark Park and may be prohibited from future use. The off-leash area shall be used at the person's own risk. Persons utilizing the Park are liable for any injury or damage caused by themselves or their dog.

Report all dog bites to Denton County Animal Services prior to leaving the park area.

- Owners are responsible for the actions and conduct of their dog(s).
- Owners are responsible for securely latching any gates as they enter or exit the dog park.
- All dogs must be leashed when entering and leaving the dog park. Owners must remain in the area at all times and keep their dogs in sight and under their control.
- Owners must pick up and dispose of dog feces properly. Pet stations are provided.
- The Bark Park is open from sunrise to sunset, unless otherwise noted. Park users and dog owners assume all risks related to the use of the dog park.
- Dog handlers must be at least 14 years of age. Children age of 13 and younger must be accompanied by an adult inside the off-leash area.
- Female dogs in heat or in season and puppies under four months of age are not allowed in the off-leash area.
- No dog food, treats or toys from home are allowed.
- Dogs must be properly vaccinated and rabies tags displayed on each dog's collar.
- Any dogs exhibiting aggressive behaviors must be leashed and removed immediately.
- Dogs with a known history of aggressive or dangerous behavior are not allowed in the park.
- Dogs less than 25 pounds must use the small dog area. Dogs 25 pounds and heavier must use the large dog area.
- Owners must not allow dogs to dig. Any holes created by a dog shall be immediately filled by the dog's owner.
- Eating and smoking are not allowed inside the off-leash area.
- Glass containers are not allowed inside the dog park.
- Dogs only on equipment.
- Professional dog trainers conducting business are prohibited.
- The Harvest HOA has the authority to close the site at any time including but not limited to maintenance, inclement weather, ground conditions, and special permit.
